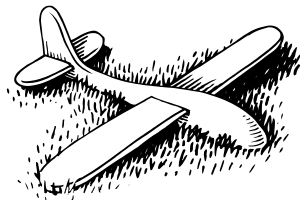

Model Kit Building Club

In recent years there have been a number of students who have expressed a wish for KA to run a model making club. This year, as a pilot, we are going to see if it is feasible. Hopefully there will be enough students who wish to attend on a regular basis and we can continue.

The focus will be on the construction and painting of model kits – the Airfix principle. We will be looking at all kinds of techniques from the absolute beginner to advanced. Students who take part will be given the opportunity to develop and enhance skills they already have and learn new ones as well. We hope to introduce such aspects of modelling as dioramas which includes terrain building and other embellishments.

Because of other staff commitments the only day it is possible to run the club is on a Tuesday. We intend the first session to take place in DT1 on September 18th, although students may join at any time in the future if space allows. This does mean however that there are no late buses available to take students home at 4.40pm, so any participant will have to make their own arrangements to get home. In view of this, we need the form below to be signed and returned to the school.

Students will be expected to supply their own kits but we will be looking at developing a central stock of tools and paints for all to use. In the first instance we can supply a small stock of these but to ensure a continuing stock we will be asking that students pay a £1 subscription per session. If anyone has any problems with this please contact us at school as we have no desire to prevent any student from taking part in the activity. Students with their own tools and paints are free to bring them to school. We will organise safe storage for them during the school day if necessary.

Our final point is about safety. Many of the tools used are dangerous if misused and anyone who does not follow the clear safety guidelines will be asked to leave the club if we feel they are a risk to themselves or others.
