



School Uniform

We firmly believe that wearing the correct uniform with pride means you come to school prepared and ready for learning. We expect all students to meet our high expectations and adhere to our dress code.



Blazer

Black blazer with King Arthur's logo. Sleeves must be rolled down.

Shirt

White, regular collar with buttons done up to the top, to be able to wear a tie.

Skirt

Black knee length. No pencil or stretchy skirts.

Tights

Black or neutral. No white socks to be worn over tights.

Shoes

Flat, black leather or leather look shoes. No boots or trainers.

Black jumper

V-neck if required. This is not instead of a blazer; it is an optional extra item.

Tie

School clip on tie or tie up version for all years.

Trousers

Black, straight leg. No skinny trousers or jeans.

Socks

Black or white socks with trousers.

Mobile phones

We allow students to bring phones into school, but they must be off and away throughout the school day. Use of a mobile phone without clear permission and supervision will lead to confiscation and will be taken to reception to be collected. A second offence requires an adult to collect, and a third offence will lead to the child handing it in every day. The 3-strike rule is for the year.

Outdoor coats

Can be worn over a blazer travelling to and from school and around the school site. Hoodies are not part of school uniform and cannot be worn on site.

PE Kit

- Black knee-length shorts or black/navy tracksuit bottoms
- Black skort or plain black full-length leggings
- Blue KA PE top
- Trainers and football boots
- Shin pads and gum shield

Hair and make up

Hair must never be of an extreme style, colour or pattern. Hair that is dyed more than one colour is not acceptable. Where hair styles are not appropriate, parents will be asked to correct their child's hair. Make up is only allowed for KS4 students and should be discrete and natural looking.

Jewellery

One pair of small stud earrings and wristwatch may be worn but must be removed for PE/DT/Science as necessary. Medical alert bracelets and necklaces may be worn. No other facial piercings may be worn including tongue, top of ear and nose piercings.
