Y9 & Y10 Somerset Careers Fair, Westlands – Thursday 9th October

We are delighted to offer the opportunity for your child to attend the Somerset Careers Fair at Westlands, Yeovil on Thursday 9th October. The purpose of the trip is to inspire and to broaden each student's awareness of the options available to them when they leave King Arthur's School at the end of Year 11; as such this will be an invaluable experience. There will be over 50 exhibitors at the event including the Armed Forces, local employers, universities, schools and colleges offering post-16 opportunities, FE college and Training providers. This forms part of our career related learning progression package for students to ensure that they make fully informed choices about the GCSE options they take (in the case of Year 9 students) as well as the opportunities available post-16 and beyond for all students on the trip.

There will be no cost associated with this trip; the trip has been funded by the Somerset 14-19 Partnership. We will be leaving King Arthur's during Period 1 and returning by the end of Period 3.

Consent should be made online through WisePay via the school website by **Wednesday 1st October**. If you need help logging into WisePay please contact the school by email trips@kingarthurs.org.uk. Details of the school's travel insurance policy can be found in the 'trips and visits' area of WisePay. Students are required to wear school uniform.

If your child may need to take medication (e.g. epipen, insulin, concerta etc) during the trip or visit, please ensure they bring this with them on the day. It is your responsibility as the parent to ensure the medication is clearly labelled with your child's name, dosage and timings required and is handed to the trip leader. Please notify the trip leader if the medication needs to be administered by a trained member of staff. We have been advised by the school nurse that students with epipens should have at least two epipens on any school trip, one on their person and one to be handed in to the trip leader. If they do not have two epipens, they will not be able to go on the trip.
