Dear Parents/Carers

Overnight and abroad trips 2026-27

We are writing to inform you of the overnight and overseas trips planned for the next academic year. We hope this overview will support your planning when deciding which trips you would like your child(ren) to attend. Each trip will require individual consent and payment, and places will be limited. However, we felt it important to share the full programme to allow you to make informed choices.

Please note that all trips are subject to students meeting our high expectations for behaviour. Failure to do so may result in a place being withdrawn. For all overseas trips, it is the responsibility of parents/carers to ensure students have a valid passport with at least six months remaining on return. Where students do not hold a UK passport, parents/carers must also ensure that all required visas and travel documentation are in place.

Year 7 (Academic Year 2026–2027)

All Year 7 students will be offered an overnight trip to London in July 2027. The approximate cost is £285, which includes transport, overnight accommodation, an evening meal, breakfast and lunch on day two. Activities include visits to London Zoo and the London Eye, a city tour and an evening meal in a restaurant. There will be sufficient places for all students who wish to attend.

Years 8 and 9 (Academic Year 2026–2027)

Students in Years 8 and 9 will be offered a four-day, three-night trip to Madrid from Thursday 27 May to Sunday 30 May 2027. The approximate cost is £800 and includes flights, accommodation and all meals. Visits will include the Royal Palace, Bernabéu Stadium and Retiro Park. There will be a maximum of 40 places available. In the following year, a trip to Normandy will also be offered to Years 8 and 9.

Year 10 (Academic Year 2026–2027)

Year 10 students will be offered a residential trip to Berlin from 18–22 February 2027 at an approximate cost of £750. This trip directly supports GCSE studies, covering German history from 1918 to the present day, including the Nazi era and the Cold War. Activities include a guided coach tour of Berlin, visits to Checkpoint Charlie, the Rausch Chocolate Shop, Potsdam and Berlin Olympic Stadium.

Years 8–11 (Academic Year 2026–2027)

A ski trip to France will take place in April 2027. There will be a maximum of 40 places, with a cost of £1,249. Further details and a sign-up letter will follow shortly.

We are also offering an outdoor adventure trip to Morzine, France, from Sunday 18 July to Saturday 24 July 2027. The cost is £950. Students have already begun signing up, but places remain. If your child is interested, please contact me directly.
