PSHRSE 9th July 2026

On Thursday 9th July, we have our final PSHRSE session of the year. This will have a variety of tasks for different year groups to be involved in.

Year 7 (those not going to London) and 8 will have a session delivered from Stand Against Violence which focuses on anti-violence. It looks at the story of a young man murdered in an unprovoked attack: a split-second decision and lifetimes legacy portrayed through the eyes of those involved and enables pupils to explore the real costs of violence.

We have been asked by the charity, Stand Against Violence, if they can photograph this session for their promotional material. If you wish your child not to be photographed for this purpose, please let me know by 3pm Wednesday by emailing Hayley.andrews@kingarthurs.org.uk. Students will be able to partake in the session either way.

Year 8 will have a two-hour session run by Young Enterprise entitled Learn to Earn. This is led by the Young Enterprise team with several businesses volunteers and supported by KA staff. This is funded by The Banks Education Foundation. Students will also spend some time with tutors looking at the skills and qualities needed in the workplace. This links well with their Yeovil college event "My Futures" last Thursday. They will also have a session run by Yeovil College HE department looking at organising and future planning,

Year 9 will be having a presentation from the Holocaust Education trust speaking. This will be insightful and should help with their understanding of history and the work they have been doing in Ethics and Philosophy. Students will also be having a session on employability skills
