Y7 Pantomime: Aladdin - Tuesday 15th December

We are pleased to offer students the exciting opportunity to attend a theatre trip to watch Aladdin, a fun-filled Christmas pantomime, at Westlands Entertainment Venue in Yeovil.

Students will arrive at school in the morning as usual. We will leave school at 12:15pm to arrive in time for the start of the performance at 1.30pm. We are aiming to return to school by 5pm. The total cost of the trip is **£24**. This includes the cost of an ice-cream which is to be preordered on WisePay. Students will have an early lunch at school at 11:30am. If they would like a cold lunch, this can be purchased during break time before lunch. Students may be able to purchase refreshments at the theatre if they would like to bring some money or a card.

This is a fantastic opportunity to develop their understanding of the key skills needed to perform on stage and to enjoy the classic pantomime and ultimate adventure of 'Aladdin'. As with all trips behaviour to date and until the trip leaves is taken into consideration. We reserve the right to withdraw students who do not meet the high levels of behaviour we expect at King Arthur's School.

Consent should be made online through WisePay by **Friday 25th September**. Your consent for this trip will also mean that you agree to collect your child on their return. By using WisePay, we can ensure all paperwork necessary for the trip is completed.

If your child may need to take medication (e.g. EpiPen, insulin, Concerta etc) during the trip or visit, please ensure they bring this with them on the day. It is your responsibility as the parent to ensure the medication is clearly labelled with your child's name, dosage and timings required and is handed to the trip leader. Please notify the trip leader if the medication needs to be administered by a trained member of staff. Students with EpiPens should have at least two EpiPens on any school trip: one on their person and one to be handed in to the trip leader. If they do not have two EpiPens, they will not be able to go on the trip.
